Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Some of the shells are in pieces or cracked. Will they still be effective?

A: Yes, each shell will work. Regardless if it is a whole shell or piece of a shell the saponin will still be released into the wash cycle. When adding soap shells to your wash bag, note that two halves are equal to one whole soap shell.

Q: When should you take the wash bag out of the washing machine?

A: The wash bag can remain inside the washing machine throughout the entire washing process. The saponin is released in small increments in cooler water. That is what makes your clothes soft and smelling fresh as it is a natural fabric softener. However, if you wish to take the bag out of the wash cycle you may do so prior to the rinse cycle.

Q: I mistakenly put the wash bag filled with Magic Washberries™ into the dryer? Are the soap shells still usable?

A: Yes, your soap shells are still usable.

What are Magic Washberries™?

The soap nuts are an environmentally friendly alternative to chemical detergents. A safe and gentle option for those with allergies to chemicals in regular detergents.

The soap nut shells absorb water and release saponins which circulate as a natural surfactant in the washing machine, freeing dirt, grime and oils from clothing.

Magic Washberries[™] are idea! for those with sensitive skin and are gentle on delicate fabrics and colors.

How To Use

- 1. Place 4-6 Magic Washberries™ in the provided reusable wash bag and tie it closed.
- 2. Drop the wash bag into your washing machine with your laundry and wash normally. Soap shells double as a fabric softener. There is no need to add additional fabric softener to each load.
- **3.** Remove the wash bag when the washing machine has finished its cycle. Set wash bag with Magic Washberries™ aside to dry or use for another load.
- **4.** Magic Washberries[™] can be used up to 10 times. Any leftover remnant after your 10th load can be disposed of or you can add additional soap shells to the bag.

Note: The number of loads may vary based on the number of Magic Washberries™ in the bag, the size of the load, the temperature of the water. Magic Washberries™ work best when wash bag has room to agitate in the washing machine.

Store Magic Washberries™ in a cool dry place. Keep away from pets and small children.

HE (High Efficiency) Machines

Magic Washberries™ are safe for both standard and high-efficiency machines (HE). Place the wash bag directly into the machine as you would in a standard washing machine.

Additional Washing Tips

Cloth Diapers: Remove any solid waste from the soiled diaper and dispose of properly. Pre-wash no more than 24 soiled diapers in cold water without adding Magic Washberries™. Once wash cycle is finished, add wash bag filled with 4-6 Magic Washberries™ into washing machine. Wash diapers on the hot setting. When the wash cycle is finished, set the wash bag aside or hang to dry.

Heavy Soils: Pre-soak 4-6 Magic Washberries™ in the wash bag for 4-5 minutes in hot water. Add the water along with the wash bag containing the Magic Washberries™ into your washing machine. Load the washing machine with fewer clothes to maximize agitation during washing cycle.

Hand Wash: Soak 2-3 Magic Washberries[™] in a wash bag for 5 minutes in hot water. Add water mix into your washbin or sink.

Multipurpose Soap: Soak 5-6 Magic Washberries™ in the wash bag for 5-10 minutes. Add the water mix along with the wash bag to a bucket of water. Water can be used to wash cars, boats, RVs, sports equipment, tents, pets, people, wetsuits, dishes, jewelry and more!
